Overton Recycling Ltd is a growing company in the treatment of end of life electrical equipment. Our processes recycle all forms of waste electrical and electronic equipment – both hazardous (commercial / domestic refrigeration and TV's / Monitors) and non – hazardous (in the form of small and large domestic appliances).

Overton Recycling and Ouroboros Reuse Ltd (a subsidiary company trading as Smart Seconds) is striving to achieve environmental best practice by implementing international standard BS EN ISO 14001:2004, relevant environmental legislation, minimisation of waste and prevention of pollution for the good of our Employees, Customers and the Local Community.

The general objective of the management system will be to control adverse environmental impacts. This will be achieved by means of:

- Ensuring that both companies comply with all relevant environmental legislation, including their site hazardous waste management licences and other pertinent requirements (such as codes of practice to which the organisation subscribes) that relate to its environmental aspects - including the international standard BS EN ISO 14001:2004.

- Communicating our policy (through training to all levels of the company) to all employees working for or on behalf of the companies (e.g. contractors) for whom adherence is mandatory and, upon request, making it available to the general public, regulatory authorities and customers.
- Monitoring and recording of the companies' energy usage and wherever possible to maximize their efficiency through best working practices.
